What is DNow?

The Disciple Now is a intown retreat. The retreat centers on small and large group atmosphere at church and in a host home for a weekend. Each group will have six to ten students of the same gender and grade that will be led by an adult leader. All groups go through a specific Bible Study that introduces them to what it means to be a Christian and encourages others in their growth as a Christian.

February 20-22. Starting at 6:00 pm with dinner and ending after the last worship service on Sunday morning.

DNow Theme

The Way: Walking in Truth

“Jesus said to him, ‘I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. If you had known me, you would have known my Father also. From now on you do know him and have seen him.’” – John 14:6-7

We are all on a journey. Every path leads somewhere, and every heart longs for the same things: truth, purpose, and life that lasts. From the very beginning, there has only been one true Way: Jesus Christ. He doesn't just point to The Way— He is The Way. The life He offers isn't about empty religion or performance; it's about relationship. It's not a path we trek on our own, but one He's already walked for us and now walks with us.

Where do students stay?

Students stay in church members' homes throughout the Middleburg area.

Are adults staying in homes?

Yes, there will be a host family and a small group leader staying in the homes with the students.

Who are the group leaders?

The group leaders are members of our church. Each volunteer goes through a background check and is vetted by our student ministry team.

What does the event fee cover?

The **\$50** event fee covers food, materials, t-shirt, and all event activities.

What will my son/daughter need for this event?

When will I know where my student will be staying?

We try to assign host homes with groups the second week of February. We do not make the assignments public until the Friday night of the event. If you need to know where your student is staying, please contact me.

What if my student has a conflict in schedule during the weekend?

That is one of the beauties of this event – it is done in town. So, if your student has a conflict and it cannot be changed, simply complete the “if not attending full event” section on the Registration Card. But, understand, we strongly encourage you to try and work it out to be there the entire time. Everything we do ties together and builds on top of the next. With this in mind it is very important that your student be there for all of D-Now.

Can my teen drive themselves around for the weekend?

We take the responsibility for student safety seriously. We don't allow students to drive themselves or friends around for this event. The church will provide transportation for each student for the whole weekend. Each driver is a church member over 25 years of age who has had a background check done and has been vetted by the student ministry staff.

Medical and Liability Release Form

As parents/guardians you will be required to turn this form in before the event. *The form must be notarized.* We will have notary available a few times for your convenience. How do I register?
